LITTLE MOVES

Do three learning activities with your child, then visit the library to get their badge!

Help your child cut shapes from magazines or scrap paper. Make collage art by gluing them to a piece of paper.
Gather yarn, string, or twine, and have your child string cereal, beads, or dried pasta. Help them make a necklace or bracelet!
Let your child draw all over a piece of cardboard or cardstock. When they're done, cut it into puzzle pieces. Work with your child to put their puzzle together.
Visit the library and practice handling books with your child. Show them how to flip the pages from right to left and let them hold the book.
Practice small motor skills by sorting items like stickers, play food, even cheerios. Count as you sort!

Accomplishing small tasks and activities gives children confidence to try bigger projects.

Learning how to read will be easier with positive confidence and a 'can do' attitude!
