SAMPLE STORYTIME

This is a sample of how you could organize the books, songs, & rhymes, but please do what feels right for you and your little one!

Starting Song: [Sing to the tune of "Farmer in the Dell"] We clap and sing hello (2x), with our friends at Storytime, we clap and sing hello! [Wave and sing hello; stomp and sing hello.]

Book One: Silly Sally by Audrey Wood

Rhyme/Song: Two Little Blackbirds

Rhyme/Song: ABCs/ The Alphabet Song

Book Two: Hickory Dickory Dock by Keith Baker

Rhyme/Song: Open Shut Them

Rhyme/Song: Down by the Bay

Book Three: Rhyming Dust Bunnies by Jan Thomas

Final Rhyme/Song: Sleeping Bunnies

After Storytime Activity/Game: Nursery Rhyme Cube

Instructions:

- 1. Assemble the paper cube or use a tissue box cube.
- 2. On each side, write the name of a nursery rhyme or draw a symbol. Color and decorate if you wish!
- 3. Roll the cube. Act out or say the nursery rhyme!
- 4. Six nursery rhymes& suggested symbols: Hickory Dickory Dock [mouse], Twinkle Twinkle Little Star [star], Old Mother Goose [bird], Jack & Jill [2 children], Humpty Dumpty [egg], Jack in the Box [box with streamers]
